Seven Chicago Area Service Projects Top Off Changing Tomorrow Day at Astellas

- Expand the food pantry, paint and create murals at the Marquard Center in Chicago's West Town neighborhood
- Paint lockers, stairwells and create murals at Dewitt Clinton Elementary School in West Rogers Park
